Here are the math problems for this newsletter, have some fun with your children working them out. Pop your answers into the box in the office.

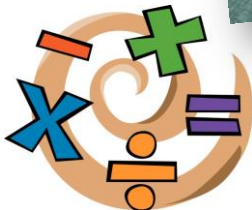
This week a lovely family has challenged us to help solve a couple of problems! Can you help?

Show how you worked out each problem and post your answer and your name into the maths box in the office to be in to win a cool prize for all the family!



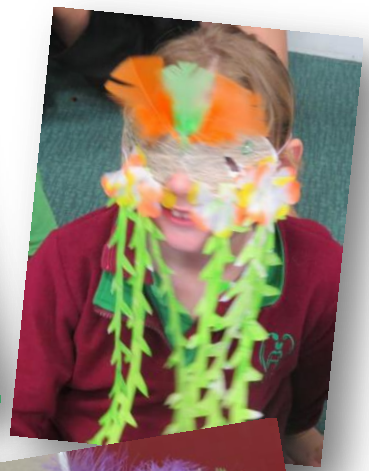
Maths

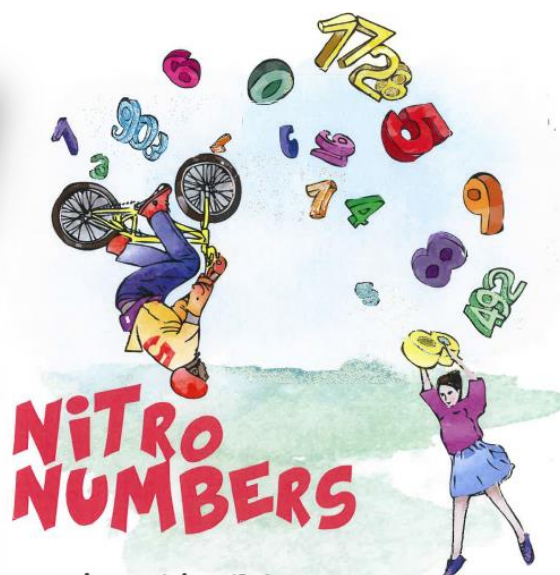
