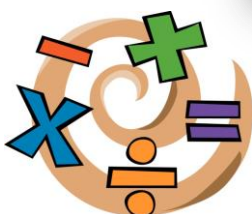
Here are the math problems for this newsletter, have some fun with your children working them out.

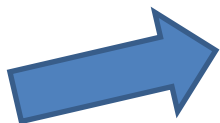
