Last Monday we had a beautiful powhiri and got to welcome everyone to Somerset Crescent School. Last week was Tongan Language Week. I got to join the Pasifka Pride Team at Lalanga Mo'ui in Vogel Street. They warmly welcomed our students, staff and parents. We performed to the young children, their staff and families and then they performed for us. It was such a lovely celebration of the Tongan language and culture. Thank you Ms. Etuale for arranging this visit for us. Mālō 'aupito mau me'a ofa fakaofaofa - Lalanga Mo'ui.

Our Kowhai Team held their Whanau Hui which again packed the hall out. It was so nice to see so many whanau come together to learn how to teach their child/ren reading, writing and mathematics at home. The achievement of the children is lifting because of the involvement and partnership between home and school. The hall looked lovely for this occasion with our 2 new, large palms in it. These are there to enhance our hall, as are the lovely plants in our administration block. Come in and have a look.

Last Friday we had our Spring themed UROCK Day. There were so many creative artworks and activities that the children got to be involved in. Thank you staff for organising this and sharing your art & craft ideas with our students.

During last week all of our Kahikatea Team were involved in a People Savers course. This was planned at this time to support everyone prior to attending camp in Week 10 at Forest Lakes so that all are well equipped with the necessary knowledge and skills that keep everyone healthy and safe. On Tuesday evening this week those parents/helpers who are attending camp with the Kahikatea Team met and went through all the important paperwork and timetables that support a successful camp for all. We are very grateful for these volunteers and could not offer such EOTC (Education Outside the Classroom) opportunities without them. The students are getting very excited - only 12 sleeps to go.

As part of Te Reo Maori Language Week this week we were fortunate to have Freyberg High schools Te Piringa Kapa Haka group perform to us. This week at our Whole School Assembly we had 3 visitors join us because they have become part of the Somerset Crescent Team.
